Coming Here. London, Sept. 28.—The Hon. Neil Primrose, Lord Rosebery's second son, has sailed for Canada by the Victoria.

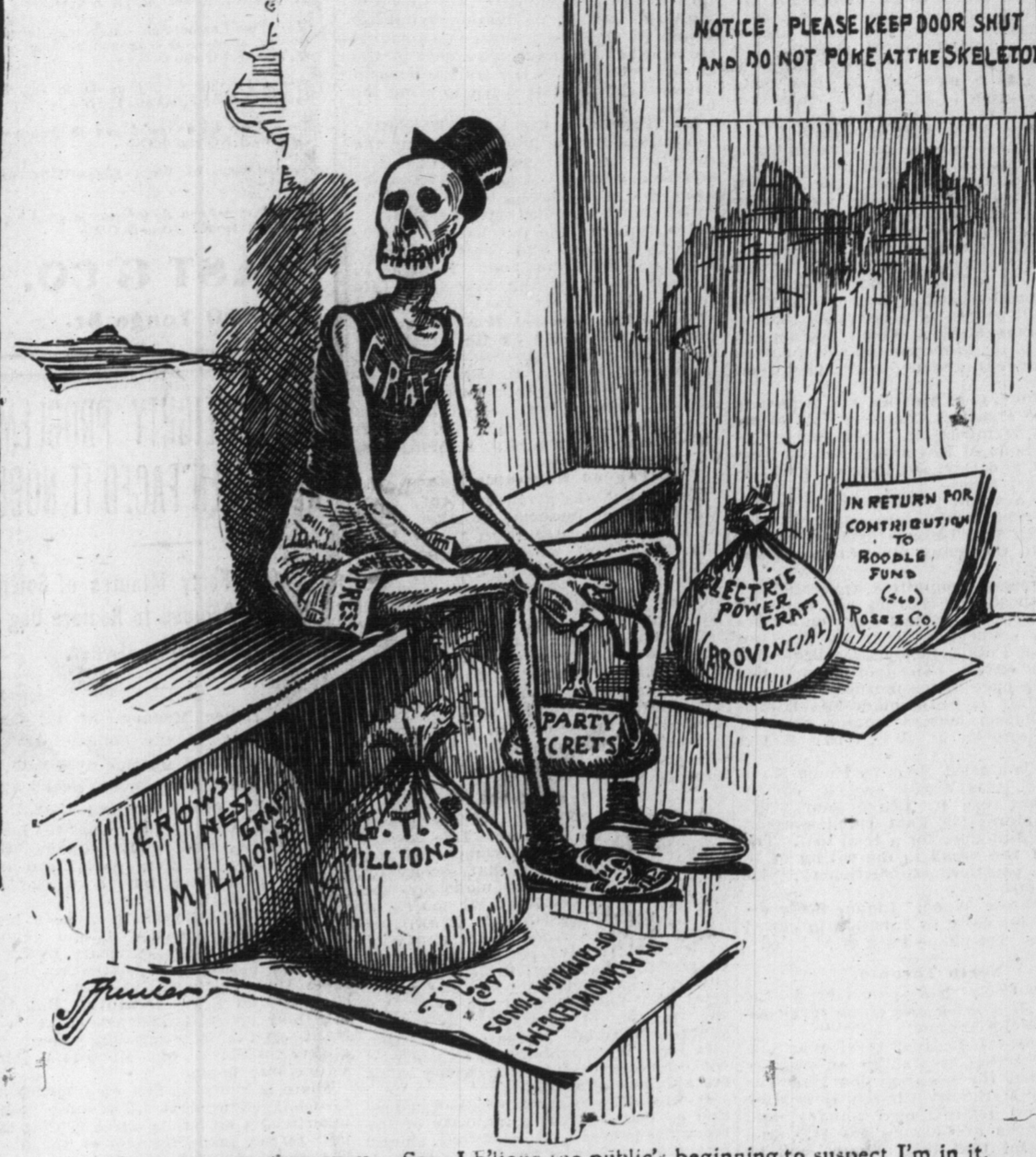
