To say that Toronto shareholders are disgusted with the directorate of the Richelleu Navigation Co. is not too strongly expressive of the feeling that existed to-day when it was again announced that the question of dividends had been postponed for a further period. Locally it is being sized up, that the dividend is being held out as a balt, and that considerable unloading of the stock is being sought under the aegis of the rumor. In Wednesday's rise in Richelieu the Toronto market was kept continuously ahead of Montreal, and sales were effected here of Montreal holdings. The Toronto market to-day was generally undecided, and no particular strength was shown except in Northern Navigation, which easily held all its recent advance.
