TODAY'S BEST RECIPE TO
HELP YOU MAKE A SACK
OF FLOUR LAST LONGEST

(By Lillian Kemp, Institutional manager, Chicago School of Domestic Arts and Science.)

Every good housekeeper substitutes muffins or biscuits for bread from time to time, in order that the family meals shall have an appealing variety. Hot muffins are a favorite delicacy; I recommend the following recipe for them to housewives who wish to get the most out of their sack of flour.

Four tablespoons butter, and four of sugar; one egg, three-quarters cup milk, two cups flour, three teaspoons baking powder. The recipe makes twelve fluffy, tasty muffins at a cost of barely one cent each.
