PREMIER SCOTT ISSUES

MANIFESTO TO ELECTORS.

Outlines Policy the Government Will Carry Out if Elected.

REGINA, Sask., July 27.—The Hon. Walter Scott, Prime Minister of Saskatchewan, has addressed a manifesto to the electors, in which he asks them to pass judgment upon the record of his government and to consider the following questions:

1. Railways—To assume a rapid extension of lines.
2. Telephones—To connect immediately all the settled districts of the province by long distance lines under the control of the government; to permit municipalities to acquire ownership and to assure the exploitation of local telephone stations; to encourage development of the rural service by furnishing at the expense of the State the necessary telephone wires, at the nearest railway station.
3. Public instruction.—Distribution to the school commissioners for gratuitous use by all scholars of the Alexandra Readers and reduced rates for all other school books.
4. Rural municipalities.—Vote at the

first session of the new Legislature of an act creating the said municipalities. The pending legislative measures of which the government has taken the initiative, for which he accepted the responsibility and on which he solicited their approbation, were, Mr. Scott said:—

1. Agricultural Associations Act; 2. Revision of the Act of Villages, Towns and Cities; 3. Act concerning the privileges of the workmen, foresters and harvesters; 4. Redistribution Act; 5. Elections Act; 6. License Act for the sale of spirituous liquors; 7. University Act; 8. High Schools Act; 9. Free School Books Act; 10. Supplementary Revenue Act; 11. Corporation Tax Act; 12. Act re Revenue Tax on Railways; 13. Supreme and District Courts Act.

MURDERS IN MACEDONIA.

CONSTANTINOPLE, July 27.—According to detailed statistics communicated to the local press by the Post, 383 murders and eighty-eight armed assaults were committed in the Rumanian villages, Macedonia, during March, April and May. In the corresponding period of last year there were 392 murders and 138 armed assaults. The criminals include Bulgarians, Greeks, Servians, Wallachians and Mohammedans.
