(c). Earning or receipts taxable under section 8 and the particulars thereof.

(2). Every person employing the services or labor of another person or of other persons shall make a statement giving the name and address of every person employed by him and the amount of wages, salaries, or other compensation paid to such employee or employees. Every firm, co-partnership, or corporation shall make a statement of the salaries, allowances, or other compensation of partners or officers.

(3). The return or statement required by this section shall be made.
