This Society was organized at East Medway, April 3, 1869, under the direction of the Harmony Quarterly Meeting.

The object of this Society is to aid destitute Churches in the Quarterly Meeting, and to spread the Gospel. The Quarterly Meeting Conference controls the business of this Society, through its Executive Committee. The Society holds public meetings in connection with each Session of the Quarterly Meeting. At these meetings addresses are delivered on the subject of Missions, collections taken, and subscriptions solicited in aid of the funds of the Society.

As the Society was very small in its beginning, having but little funds, it was not advisable to engage a Missionary, and there being no missionary to support, there has not been that effort made to gather funds which the enterprise demands. There is, however, a small amount in fund, and considerable hope that as soon as the missionary can be found to labour the Society will be prepared to support him.

We trust that the friends of Missions and suffering humanity will co-operate in this good work, and that the little Society will grow and thrive, and under God's blessing be the means of great good.
