Further Business of the Annual Meeting.

The Report of the Building Committee having been received and adopted the Committee was discharged.

A unanimous vote of thanks was tendered to the Committee for their labors and particularly to Mr. A. C. Hutchison for his kindness in furnishing plans and specifications and superintending the building and alterations of the church free of charge.

It was resolved to increase the number of Managers from six to eight.

Mr. A. C. Hutchison gave notice that at the next general meeting he would move-that the following words in Article V. of the Constitution be deleted, viz:

"Adherents who are members in good standing of other Presbyterian con-

"gregations may be declared eligible for election as Managers by consent of

"the majority of members present."

The Officers and Managers for 1889 were elected.

The Board of Managers were authorised to borrow temporarily a sum not exceeding \$1200 to pay off the floating debt due for the enlargement of the building, the President and Treasurer, if necessary, to sign a note therefor on behalf of the congregation.
