named for this purpole, viz. on the part of his Britannic Majefly Mr. Alleyne Hitz-Herbert, Minister Plenipotentiary of his thid Majefly the King of Great-Britain; and on the part of his Most Christian 'Majesty, Charles Gravier, Comte de Vergennes, Counfellor in all his councils, Commander of his Orders, Counfellor of State, Minister and Secretary of State, and of the Commands and Finances of his faid Majesty, for the department of Foreign Affairs; who, after having duly communicated to each other their full powers in good form, have agreed on the following Preliminary Articles :
