## And Act to provide for the more convenient assembling of Parliament.

THEREAS it is expedient that the time and place of meet- Preamble. ing of the Provincial Parliament should be established by Law, and not left to the discretion of the Executive Government; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

- 5 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Where and at three next Sessions of the Parliament of this Province shall be Sessions of the held at the City of Quebec, on the first Tuesday in February, and Parliament all succeeding Sessions of Parliament shall be holden on the same day in each successive year; and that the four Sessions thence
- 10 next ensuing shall be held at the City of Toronto, and again at Quebec for the like period, and so alternately for four years at each city until otherwise provided by an Act of the Legislature : Provided always, that it shall be lawful for His Excellency the unforeseen Governor General, by Proclamation under the Great Seal, to call cases.
