that the labours of the Commissioners should be restricted to those places where the whites and natives are living in close producity and to those localities where the Indians are dissatisfies with the area of land of which they now hold possession, That this portion of the labors of the Commissioners might be completed before the close of the present year when the Commission might be dissolved, That after the dissolution of the Commission the Superintendents of Indian affairs in their respective loca. lities should apportion as soon as prac. - ticable all the lands runaining unallotted or unreserved by the present Commission, such apportionment to be subject to the approval of the Chief Com. - missioner of Lands and Horks of British Columbia acting on behalf of the Local Government, and in the event of any difference between the Superintendents and the Chief Commissioner as to the estert or locality of the lands to be allot. ted, the matter might be referred to one of the Judges of the Supreme Court of that Province whose decision should be final. That the suggestions of the Province cial Secretary have been approved by the local Government of British Columbia by their brder in Council of the 30 th ultimo
