with you all for me, and will give you tobacco
to show you that the English are on good terms
with you.

The friendship that is between the English
and the Dakota is always the same and will
exist as long as you respect the whites and
give the hand of friendship to the whites.

The Governor is very sorry that he
did not see you. he thought you were only
the Sioux from the Postage. — you should have
stopped and explained to the proper parties
where you had come from and what tribe
you represented.
