Antoine the old Chippewagan  
chief used to draw treaty for his  
wife Emily, after his death his  
widow drew the money for some  
years, since then the girl has not  
received annuity - Payments 1892  
show both women absent. Report  
1894. Remarks are Antoine's widow  
transferred to Cold Lake, Onon Lake  
Agency, reported "she supported the  
dead". The Chippewagan Indians  
claim that this report was a  
mistake, that the girl was living  
in the north, and married to  
Andre Spence an non-treaty half-breed  
Indian, and appears as claimed for  
Emily Spence by the Chippewagan  
Band.
