to International Red Cross for information which Red Cross had obtained regarding allegations by belligerents of violation of International Conventions on dunduct of warfare. Lastly, following appeal was addressed Italian Ethiopian Governments:-

"Committee Thirteen, having taken note of
the Ethiopian and Italian Governments' communications to the Secretary General regarding
various breaches international agreements,
conduct of war, desires to give expression to
the emotion felt by public opinion and urgently
appeals to two belligerents to take all necessary
steps to prevent any breach of said Conventions
and of principles of international law. Committee
hopes to receive from the powers to which it
addresses this appeal assurances that will tend
to allay the emotion to which it has referred."

Executive Committee of International Committee
Intellectual Cooperation of League met Paris sixth to
ninth April, Chairman Gilbert Murray, United Kingdom.
Considered various questions especially organization of
a "Conversation" on the part played by the humanities
in the training of contemporary man, certain educational
questions, international conference on protection national

statute of authors' rights by harmonising Berne Havana
Conventions, organization of conference Madrid on
scientific study international relations and social
science, problem intellectual (An --?), organization at
Geneva of international Conference to conclude convention
on use of broadcasting in interests of peace.
