Equal Pay Act

Equal pay for equal work legislation should include a special section relating to equal advancement.

Education

Girls attending high school should be informed that technical and vocational schools are opened to them.

There should be a provincial law dealing with home ownership that would permit single women to get a mortgage on a house if her income is stable and sufficient.
