Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 1st instant and previous correspondence relating to the proposed road or street along the water front of the Mission Indian reserve, Burrard Inlet, B.C. I beg to inform you that the Solicitor for the Vancouver, Westminster and Yukon Railway Co., has shown that the delay on the part of the said Company to arrange for the purchase of the Right of Way previously applied for along the front of the said Indian reserve has not been the fault of the Company and that their application should receive consideration. It has therefore been decided to allow the Company a reasonable length of time to close the matter.

Enclosed herewith for your information is a blue print plan showing the said Right of Way; it is to be noted that if the eastern end of your proposed road were moved north it would then not interfere with the said Right of Way required by the Vancouver, Westminster and Yukon Ry.
