In Connection with the question of the issue location tickets to Indians on Walpale Island, I beg say that in Inspector McGibbon has arranged with the that no trakets are to be issued for lands situate on St. Anne's Island, or on any bush land, and I have to quest, therefore, that you will be good enough to take as early as possible with the Indiane the question of locating them.

You should prepare a new list of locatees, in view the protection of Indians who have and are in Maneusian of their present holdings.

Should there be any applications for location tickets on which you require the ruling of the Departm these should be on a list by themselves, and all appli tions that you own recommend should also be in a separ list. This will avoid holding back locations until a ciston is arrived at on applications which there may b some doubt about. Indians who have been in possession holdings for years should be considered as justly entito location tickets.
