council do not wish to admit them to their meetings, they have a perfect right to exclude them.

After this matter quiete down, I should be glad to receive from you a list of the names of the present members of the Oneida council with dates of appointment, if you can obtain the same.

three-year elective system be applied to the Oneidae,
I beg to say that, no matter how desirable it might be,
the repartment would not take any steps towards that end
unless it were first assured that such was the wish of
the majority of the members of the Oneida band.
