If its terms are satisfactory to you, please endorse the resolution to be forwarded to the Clerk of the House of Commons for the Order Paper.

If it is to stand in your name, will you please so indicate. Mr. Mackenzie said this morning that he was unwilling to have it stand in his name because of the limitation regarding titles inserted in clause (b).

It was suggested that the resolution might stand in Mr. Ralston's name, which would have the advantage of emphasizing the military character of the problem.
