- I wonder if you could tell me when the cell blocks are occupied and when the living huts are occupied?
  All the time, Sir Some live in the living huts and some in A. the cell blocks.

## QUESTION BY THE PROSECUTION THROUGH THE COURT

- The question of occupation should be cleared up. There are so many kept in the cell blocks and so many kept in the living huts?
- Yes, Sir.

## QUESTIONS BY THE DEFENCE THROUGH THE COURT

- You told the Court that you knewit was after parade hours because you didn't come on duty until 1630 hours. What day are you talking about, the 8th or 9th?
- The 9th, Sir. A.
- Are you telling the Court that you didn't come on duty until 0.
- 1630 hours? I had something to eat and when I came back it was after 1630 A. hours
- You told the Court that you knew it was after parade hours because you didn't come on duty until 1630 hours? Were you not on duty until 1630 hours on the 9th?
- I was on duty befor that but I went in for something to eat and when I came back there it was after 1630 hours because the shift from "C" Compound was just changing.
