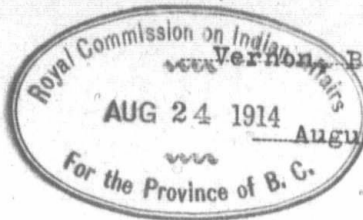

Replying to your letter of the 17th.,

 acknowledge the receipt of the copy of the Game Act and letter
 accompanying same relating to permits, I consider it my duty
 to always carry it round with me and whenever I hold a meet-
 ing of any Band discuss its contents especially Sections
 8 and 9.

I may further state that the Indians
 who needed the venison most complained that they were unable
 to shoot and therefore the permission would not benefit
 them. I have forwarded names of chiefs to Mr. Williams.
