3d. It shall be incumbent on the Chair-
man at all meetings to receive motions,
which must be in writing, accompanied
with the names of the Members who
move and second them, and to submit
the same, without comment, to the Meet-
ing.

II. THE RECORDING SECRETARY.

1st. He shall attend at all General and
Anniversary Meetings. When the Chair
shall have been taken at General Meet-
ings, he shall read the minutes of the
preceding Meeting, and shall afterwards
take minutes of the proceedings of the
present Meeting, and at Anniversary
Meetings he shall transact such business
as he is directed, under that head, to at-
tend to.

2d. He shall keep a register of all the
Society's proceedings; he shall cause
notice of all Meetings of the Association
to be inserted in two of the Quebec
newspapers, at least forty-eight hours
before the same shall take place, which
notices shall be in the French and Eng-
lish languages.

3d. The Recording Secretary, for the
year ensuing, at the Anniversary Election
