HOMESTEAD

REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-wast Territories, excepting S and 36, which has not been homestended, or reserved to profide wood home sections, or for other purposes, may be home the section of the purposes, may be sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter sec-tion of 100 acres, more or less.

ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken in situate, or if the homestender desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioned Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for Immigration, which the land is situate, receive authorities for a which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee of \$10 is charged for a homestead entry

HOMESTEAD DUTIES

A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto to perform the conditions connected herewith, under one of the following plans:—

At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any person who is eligible to make a homestead entry upon the provisions of this and entered for by such person as a home-stead, the requirements of this Act as to re-sidence prior to obtaining patent may be satisfied by such person reading with the father

(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for his homestead, or a certificate for the issue of such patent countersigned in themanner pre-scribed by this Act, and has obtained entry for a second homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the first homestead, if the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used above is meant to indicate the same township or an adjoining or cornering township.

A settler who avails himself of the provision of Clauses (2)(3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acres of his homestead, or substitute 20 head of stock with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.

Every homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homesteader law is liable to have his entry cancelled, and the land may be again thrown open for entry.

APPLICATION FOR PATENT

Should be made at the end of the three years before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or the tion for patent the settler must give at months notice in writing to the Commissioned of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of his intention to do so.

INFORMATION
