To His Excellency the Lieutenant-Go-Recising the first Volume of the vernor or Commander in Chief for the time Live. time, the sum of one hundred pounds, towards defraying the expense of revising the first volume of the Laws of this Province. and printing two hundred copies of the same, agreeably to a resolution of this House on

the twenty-eighth day of February.

To the Clerk of the House of Assembly, Contingencies of the Session. for defraying the contingent expenses of the present Session, the sum of two hundred and five pounds seventeen shillings and two-

pence.

II. And be it further enacted, That all the To be paid by beforementioned sums of money shall be paid by the Treasurer, by warrant of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, by and with the advice and consent of His Majesty's Council, out of the monies now in the Treasury, or as payments may be made at the same. 3/9/09
