

A Bill to continue, for a limited time, the levying of the Duties imposed by the Provincial Act of the forty-fifth year of His Majesty George the Third, Chapter Thirteenth, and for applying a certain sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned, was, according to order, read a second time.

Mr. *Papineau*, moved, seconded by Mr. *François Caron*;

That the said Bill be now committed to a Committee of the whole House.

Mr. *Coffin* moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. *Bell*;

To strike out the word "now," and insert "on Monday next."

The House divided on the question of amendment, and the names being called for, they were taken down, as follows:

So it passed in the negative.

Mr. *Blanchet* moved, in amendment to the main question, seconded by Mr. *Coffin*;

To leave out all the words after "that," and insert "the House do now resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the first order of the day."
