*And be it further enacted*, that the sums of Money hereby granted shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Colony in discharge of such Warrant or Warrants as shall be issued by the Governor or Person administering the Government for the time being, in favor of any Person or Persons, to be applied to the purposes of this Act; and it shall not be lawful for the said Treasurer to pay any sum or sums of Money out of the Treasury of the Colony other than such as are expressed and directed in this or some other Act or Acts of the Legislature of this Colony. Such Monies to be paid by the Governor's Warrant on the Treasurer.
