PROCLAMATION.

JAS. CROWDY

By His Honor JAMES CROWDY, Esquire, Administrator of the Government of the Island of Newfoundland, and its Dependencies, &c. &c.

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until TUESDAY the Tenth day of August instant: And whereas I think fit to Prorogue the said General Assembly until FRIDAY the Twenty-fourth day of September next ensuing:

I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until FRIDAY the Twenty-fourth day of September next; of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Government House, at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, the Sixth day of August, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-two, and in the Sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
