Helpful Discourse on Tomorrow's S. S. Lesson.

SUNDAY SCHOOL, SATURDAY NIGHT

Lesson IV.—First Quarter, For Jan. 25, 1914.

THE INTERNATIONAL SERIES.

Text of the Lesson, Luke VIII, 1:3; x, 38-42—Memory Verses, Luke x, 40-42—Golden Text, Math. xxv, 40—Commentary by Rev. D. M. Stearns.

The title of this lesson, "Ministering to Jesus," is a fascinating one and is found in chapter VIII, 3, concerning the women who ministered unto Him of their substance. Angels delighted to minister unto Him when He was here in humiliation, as they did in the wilderness after His conflict with the devil (Matt. iv, 11); also at His birth in Bethlehem and at His resurrection and in Gethsemane. He was always ready and no doubt always, according to Ps. ciii, 26, 27, where we read of them as ministers of His that do His pleasure, hearkening unto the voice of His word.

What an honor unspendable for us, who are saved sinners, to minister in any way unto Him who made us, who came from heaven to redeem us, who died for our sins, who as the risen Christ lives for us in God's right hand and with us in His kingdom and glory with us. He was always showing His great tidings of the kingdom of God (viii, 1) and giving samples of life in His kingdom by healing all manner of disease (Matt. ix, 23), for when the kingdom comes the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick, and the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity" (isa. xxxiii, 24).

Forgiveness of sins is the first step toward the kingdom, as we learn from Luke xiv, 46, 47; Acts xiii, 38, 39, and that this is the privilege of all who receive Him in plenty (John i, 12; 1, 6, 7; Col. 1, 12-14; Rev. i, 6, 7. "We must not think of the church as the kingdom nor Christ in us nor ought but that spoken of by our Lord when He taught us to pray, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, as in heaven, so on earth" (Luke xi, 20). It is in being with Israel, who shall be all righteous and all of them shall know Him from the least of them unto the greatest of them.

Jerusalem shall be the throne of the Lord, and all the nations shall be gathered unto it to the name of the Lord, for it shall be the first city of truth on earth (isa. lx, 21; Jer. xxxi, 34; 11, 17; Zech. viii, 3, 7, 8, 22, 23). While we wait for the kingdom and live to hasten it, we must not extend it, for we cannot extend that which has not begun, we may daily minister unto Him in all that we do. These women were true believers, and all believers are kings and priests unto God (Rev. i, 5, 6). We are reminded of a sentence concerning priests in the priest's office" (Ex. xviii, 1, 3, 4, and elsewhere, these ten words being the translation of two little words in Hebrew.

The words "unto Him" in verse 3 of this part of our lesson mean, "unto Him," most helpful words for our daily life, such as "unto Him that loved us," "unto Him that is able," "unto Him be glory," "unto Him who died for us and rose again" (Rev. i, 5;
