ing for the m-n who have gone to Manitoba expecting to secure work and earn wages in harvesting Mani-toba's big grain crop. A despatch in Thursday's Post announced that a hundred Ontario men had returned to Winnipeg after a fruitless search for work. With this was given a statement from the Manitoba provincial officials that if all the farmers a.ong the line of the railway were supplied there were still plenty of opportanities on 'he branch lines. A St. John exchange says.—"Yesterday S. S. deForest of this city received a dewent out on one of the excursion specials, stating that there are now in Winnipeg fifteen nundred laborers Winnipeg fifteen nundred laborors who cannot secure work. This is a very serious condition of affairs. for most of the men from the Maritime Provinces took away little money with them, expecting to secure work without difficulty. If they have to spend any considerable length of time in the prairie province before securing work they will have a hard time of it. Some of those who went West have alr ady communicated with relatives asking advice as to their future movements, and it is not unlikely that the next few days will see the return of a good many of them."
