NOTES FROM ENGLISH PAPERS

The Queen's Birthday. That, of the 1st instant, says,—Instructions will go by the mail of last day (Dec. 1) to the Commandant of the naval station at Portsmouth. It entitles the commanding officer of the ports of New Granada, to enter into the port of Callao, in order to bring to entry into effect, after his arrival, an agreement formally entered into with a British subject, Mr. James Macintosh.

It is known, has been carried to its utmost point, not only by our present Foreign Secretary, but by his predecessors in office, in their dealings with this and the other Central and South American Republics, owing to the allowances made for their immaturity and the peculiar circumstances of their position. But, with the exception of Chile, which has pursued an independent course, such as to entitle it to a leading rank among the South American market, they have almost all sunk to a depth in which every reliance upon their word faith has been extinguished.

Parliament has been prorogued until Tuesday, the 2d of February, when it is to meet for the despatch of public business.

Judge Halliburton, author of "Sam Slick," has engaged to deliver an address on the 16th instant, to the members of the Manchester Athenaeum. This address is to be followed by subsequent ones during the winter from Lord Lyttelton, Sir Robert Peel, and Lord Stanley.

The House of Deputies at Smolnopolis.—A letter from St. Petersburg, published in the *Mousieur de l'Arme*, states that the subscription opened in Russia for erecting a monument to the Russian officers and soldiers killed at Smolnopolis has produced a sum of 60,000 silver roubles.

The monument is to consist of a vast funeral chapel, which will be constructed at the end of the cemetery.

The names of the officers killed, and those of the corps and regiments who took part in the struggle, will be inscribed on tablets of black marble.

INTERESTING SCIENTIFIC EXPEDITION.—The *Telegraph*, of the 18th ult., says.—"The Gorgon, steam frigate, lately arrived here from England, on her way to the Admiralty on a scientific expedition to the Island of Cos. It would appear that the British vice-consul of that island has discovered the remains of what is considered to be an ancient Greek city; and that he applied to the home government for the means of prosecuting researches, which promises to be very interesting. The Gorgon has on board implements for excavating, and scientific instruments to facilitate the work. A good camera obscura and microscope are also on board, so that any inscription or statuary which may be brought to light will be photographed on the spot."

The work will, we are informed, be carried on under the superintendence of the vice-consul. The expedition, it is said, will throw considerable light on some portion of the history of ancient Greece. Cos is one of the islands of the Archipelago, situated at no great distance from the coast of Asia Minor. The Gorgon left on the 12th for Smyrna."

His family, however, are not of English extraction, but Scotch. He was the representative of the "giants of steam" at the age of 70, and has left four stalwart sons.

MEMORIAL OF HISTORIAN.—Letters from Tehran of October 20th, in the *Paris d'Orient*, reduce to very small dimensions the shock experienced by the besiegers, and that nothing short of a miracle could save the city from capture. The Persians expected with great delight the approaching hour of their success. The *Globe*, in an article vindicating the Anglo-Persian expedition against Herat, says, "The plain facts are that in 1856 the Shah intended not to send any expedition to Herat, unless it were an expedition to succour it from foreign foes; and that he had broken his word, and sent an expedition which had sailed close to the town. The next fact is, that his only interest to keep the Persians out of Herat, before their arrival in the halfway house to the head road to the south, and that Herat is less likely to be used again than it was before Persian or Afghan. There is a Power, who, by his power—craft, and force, can make—increase, and increase, creeping gradually up to the frontiers of Persia, until, through these agencies, awfully with the purpose of bringing conclusions with British arms at a comparatively small cost. Are we to sit still and take no measure of prevention, because the public cannot foresee the precise object of our interference? It is all very well to let the tribes that wander in the regions between Herat and the Indus, fight it out among themselves, with the loss of human life. We must adopt this policy; but there is another power in Asia that will not. We have to compete; its frontiers touch on the frontiers of our empire. Russia has a huge empire held under the skin. There are only two Powers in Central Asia. Every step of Russian gain is British loss. Some such steps we can do nothing to prevent; there are others more or less, which, to a certain extent, we can control, if not wholly. The question of who shall hold Herat is one of our business now, and the settle it as quickly as possible, as it is given unto mortals to settle such difficult things."

MEMORIAL OF A COUNTRYSIDEMAN.—At a demonstration in the hall of the Earl of Fife, the following speech was delivered by Captain McDonald:—"It is now the eleventh hour with me.
