The agreement between the Dominion government and Norton Griffiths, Limited, for the 'development of Courtenay Bay, on the east side of St. John, was signed a few days ago. The contract involves an expenditure of upwards of \$11,000,000, the schem calling for development of the port on a very large scale. A great deal of dredging will be done, a breakwater upwards of a mile in length will be built, and a dry dock of the largest size is included in the plan.


