THE PROVINCIAL FINANCES.

Suppose it was true, as a Victoria contemporary affirms, that half of the million dollar loan negotiated by the government in the early part of the present year had been spent, it does not follow that it has not been used in the promotion of useful and necessary works. If it has been so spent in the opinion of the government the question for discussion is whether they are works of immediate necessity and utility. There may be room for a difference crops up in the case of all expenditures, and if unanimity of opinion were a necessity to public expenditure there would be none. Before the government is condemned it should be known how the money has been used. It was obtained for the purpose of expending, and it may as well be used in this way as kept lying in the bank. When the house meets and a statement is submitted by the government of its expenditure there public will be in possession of the facts and can form its own opinion.


