or "banking institution," without being authorized so to do by this Act, or by some other Act in force in that behalf; is guilty of an offence against this Act. .

Penalty for offence Act.

Repeal of

101. Every person, committing an offence declared to be an against this offence against this Act, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years, or to both, in the discretion of the court before which the conviction is had.

PUBLIC NOTICES.

How notices 102. The several public notices by this Act required to be shall be gi given shall, unless otherwise specified, be given by advertisement in one or more newspapers published at the place where the head office of the bank is situate, and in the Canada Gazette.

DOMINION GOVERNMENT CHEQUES.

103. The bank shall not charge any discount or commission Government cheques to for cashing any official cheque of the Government of Canada or be paid of any department thereof, whether drawn on itself or on another bank.
