Resolved, That a Committee of five be appointed with full powers to make such arrangements as they may deem advisable, for the publication of a National Organ, and to select an editor for the same.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be appropriated from the funds of this body, to be paid, under the direction of said Committee, at stated intervals during one year, for the support of such publication.
