for the procurement of materiel, equipment, installations, transportation, construction, maintenance, supplies, services and civil labor from private, commercial or government sources at a scale and standard no greater than required to provide adequate and economical support and all in accordance with the procedures, terms and conditions applicable to such procurement and construction for the Canadian Forces. In exceptional cases, the Ministry of Defence may be authorized to procure supplies and services locally subject to relevant provincial and federal laws and regulations. Subject to paragraphs 6 and 7 below, any significant change in the scale or scope of the goods, services and facilities provided to the United Kingdom by Canada shall be the subject of consultation and mutual consideration by the participants as soon as possible before the proposed change is due to be implemented.

6. The United Kingdom shall bear the costs of the training programmes of the British Armed Forces in Canada except in those instances when it is agreed to share the costs between users of the facilities in accordance with the arrangements set out in the relevant Memorandum of
