

Debate was resumed on the motion of Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton), seconded by Mr. Sharp,—That this House approves in general the budgetary policy of the Government.

And on the motion of Mr. Stevens, seconded by Mr. Wagner, in amendment thereto,—That all the words after the word "That" be deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"this House deploras the failure of the government's budget to deal with inflation and provide for a healthy economy; and in particular regrets the social injustice inherent in both the ten cent gasoline tax and the lack of necessary action to encourage the provision of housing at reasonable cost for Canadians."

And on the motion of Mr. Broadbent, seconded by Mr. Knowles (Winnipeg North Centre), in amendment to the proposed amendment,—That the amendment be amended by changing the period at the end thereof to a semi-colon, and by adding immediately thereafter the following words:

"this House also regrets the gross injustice of the disguised and regressive tax on every working man and woman in Canada involved in higher premiums for unemployment insurance, as well as the serious injustice of the Federal Government's unilateral decision to renege on its commitments to the Provinces in respect of the cost of hospital and medical services."

And debate continuing;
