IMMIGRATION, NOVA SCOTIA, 1953-57

Question No. 302—Mr. MacEachen:

How many immigrants have settled in Nova Scotia for each year 1953 to 1957, inclusive?

Answer by: Hon. E. D. Fulton (Acting Minister of Citizenship and Immigration):

The statistics quoted below represent those persons who, on arrival in Canada, gave the

province of Nova Scotia as their destination. These statistics do not necessarily represent the number of immigrants who have settled permanently in that province:

1953	2206
1954	2207
1955	1841
1956	1639
1957	2405*

*The total for 1957 is for the period January to September inclusive. Statistics are not yet available for the last quarter of 1957.
