RETRAINING PROGRAM NO. 5

Question No. 2,337—Mr. Hales:

1. How many people were enrolled in program 5 in Canada during the month of November, 1966?
2. How many people have graduated in the program 5 course since its inception?
3. Are those people enrolled in program 5 included in the unemployment figures for Canada?

Mr. J. C. Munro (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Manpower and Immigration):

1. Figures for enrolment of trainees in program 5 in Canada during the month of November, 1966 will not be available until the latter part of January, 1967.

2. There were 96,152 persons reported as having graduated from program 5 courses from April 1, 1961 to March 31, 1966.

3. Persons enrolled in program 5 courses are included in the unemployment figures for Canada.
