Dear Sir Arthur Currie

Col. Foster saw me last week & said that he would see you in Ottawa this week and Mr. Deane also said that he would see you - I am at present employed at the S.C.R. here but it may close down any day & I am very anxious to get some Government job before I get out of here, I was told by the Doctors to come to Victoria after I had double Pneumonia in England just previous to returning to Canada, I am now 50 years of age & not as full of work as I was when I joined the 5th Bn, which I helped to raise, I did a long time in France with the Battalion & had no Bomb proof jobs, was mentioned in Despatches & Received the D.S.O. Surely there must be some permanent Semi military position I could be given, if not in Victoria at some other place, I would of course like to remain here but am willing to go anywhere where an opening offers, or there must be many Government appointments which could be given
