to the layout and construction of the building, and lack of available space, it is practically impossible to provide such accommodation. 4. The drafting rooms are open to architectural students until 10 p.m., and an important part of the work is done in the evening. From 5 p.m. until 10 p.m. there is no staff supervision, discipline being maintained by the students themselves. This plan has worked admirably, but the advent of women students would obviously require the supervision of a member of the staff during the evening hours. As no member of the staff is now available for such duty a new appointment would be necessary. For these reasons the Faculty feels that it cannot recommend to Corporation that women be admitted to the Department of Architecture under present conditions. Yours faithfully. Dean.
