Section 15.

VI. The President of the Court shall issue summons for compelling the attendance of witnesses, and such summons shall be served by a serjeant. The person doing the duty of Judge Advocate shall cause to be administered to the witnesses this oath to tell the truth "The evidence you shall give to this Court Martial on the trial of A. B. shall be the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. So help you God."

Section 12.

VII. The sentence of the Court can only extend to censure or suspension, deprivation of the commission, and degradation from rank.

sec. 13.

VIII. The sentence is not valid without the concurrence of at least two thirds of the number of officers present, and shall not be executed until after its approval by the Governor.

Section 16.

The Court Martial shall tax the expenses and pay of the witnesses.

52, G. III.
sec. 19.

The fines and punishments imposed by the Act 52, G. III. concerning the Militia embodied for actual service, shall be sued for before a general or regimental Court Martial, according to the "Rules and Articles for the better Government of the Militia of the Province of Lower Canada, when embodied for service."
