BILL 11.

An Act respecting The Burrard Inlet Tunnel and Bridge Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that 1910, c.*74. it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate 5 and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The Burrard Inlet Tunnel and Bridge Company may Extension of commence the construction of its bridge and tunnel and of time. the lines of railway which it is authorized to construct, and expend fifteen per cent of the amount of its capital 10 stock thereon, within two years after the passing of this Act, and may complete the said bridge and tunnel and lines of railway which it is authorized to construct, and put them in operation, within five years after the passing of this Act; and if the said bridge and tunnel and the said lines of railway are 15 not so commenced and such expenditure is not so made, or if the said bridge and tunnel or the said lines of railway are not completed and put in operation, within the said periods respectively, the powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null 20 and void as respects so much of the said bridge and tunnel, or so much of the said lines of railway, as then remains uncompleted.

2. Section 1 of chapter 80 of the statutes of 1913 is 1913, c. 80, repealed.
