

It shall be competent for the congregation of any Chapel of Ease or place of worship other than the Mother Church of a Parish, to appoint annually, at Eastertide, two Churchwardens and two Sydesmen, whose duties shall be the same as in this Canon, but shall be confined to the Chapel or place of worship for which they are appointed.

RELATIVE POSITION OF INCUMBENT AND CHURCHWARDENS.

Divine service shall be performed at usual and convenient times. The Incumbent has the discretionary power of fixing these times, under the control of the Bishop, on being appealed to by the Churchwardens.

The Incumbent has the entire direction of the playing and singing in the church.

The Church Bells are not to be rung without good cause, nor without the joint consent of the Incumbent and the Churchwardens.

No Monuments or Mural Tablets are to be set up in the church without the joint consent of the Incumbent and Vestry.

V.

CANON ON FINANCE.

For the proper management and administration of the funds of the Diocese, there shall be a Finance Committee appointed, which shall consist of the Executive Committee of the Synod.

The following principles shall, as far as possible, be kept in view, and be acted upon by the Finance Committee :

1 To apply the funds of the Diocese so as to elicit the greatest amount of local assistance, and to render each Parish, as soon as possible, self-supporting.

2 To raise the stipends of the clergy according to a certain scale.

3 To render the payment of stipends as certain and as regular as possible.

4 To relieve the Incumbents of Parishes, etc., of the unpleasant, invidious, and derogatory task of pleading for their own stipends.

The stipend, from all sources, of a clergyman in Deacon's orders, shall be, if possible, not less than \$800 per annum ; of a clergyman in Priest's orders, of three years' standing, or under, in the Diocese, not less than \$900 per annum ; of a Priest, of from three to five years' standing, not less than \$1,000 per annum ; and of a Priest of over five years' standing, at least \$1,200 per annum ;—if the funds of the Diocese will permit of such payments.
