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1917 VICTORY FOR ALLIES HEALED BY LLOYD GEORGE

BRITISH GREEKS BEGIN GUNS DELIVERY TODAY, AFTER MANY MONTHS

Acceptance of Allied Ultimatum Stirs 'Tino to Action.
RESERVISTS ARE CHECKED
Hostile Demonstration Summarily Dismissed by King.
TROOPS MUST KEEP QUIET
Given Orders To Suppress Any Uprisings Following Decision To Obey Entente.

Athens, Jan. 10, via London, Jan. 11.—The Government has formally accepted the ultimatum of the Entente Powers.
In accordance with the agreement made with the Allies on December 1, King Constantine today began delivery to the Entente naval authorities of six batteries of mountain guns. He gave orders to the troops to suppress all hostile demonstrations, which was promptly done, and a meeting called to protest against the acceptance of the Allied ultimatum was summarily dispersed. The leaders of the reservists, under pressure from the king, issued a statement that their followers were ready to support the monarch and accept the decisions of his Government.

An ultimatum was delivered to the Greek Government last November demanding, among other things, that the artillery of the Greek army be turned over for the Entente naval authorities. This demand was

ITALIANS TAKE ALBANIAN TOWN ON CORITZA RIVER

Batteries Also Disperse Enemy Troops South of Gorizia.
Rome, Jan. 11.—Via London.—"On the Trentino front the activity of our artillery was hindered by heavy snow-falls and blizzards," says today's report from the war office. "On the Julian front there were intermittent attacks and trench mortar actions, and some activity on the part of our patrols. Our batteries dispersed enemy troops near the Valsugana railway station southwest of Gorizia."

ENTENTE REPLY IS NOW BEFORE U. S. PRESIDENT

BRITISH SMASHING WAY TO VICTORY THROUGH TURKISH DEFENCES IN EASTERN LINES

Capture 1,600 in Sinai Peninsula, and Six Lines of Trenches.
BIG KUT VICTORY TOO
Indian Troops Take 1,000 Yards of Trenches There.

London, Jan. 11.—Six lines of entrenchments covering the town of Rafa, on the Sinai Peninsula, have been captured by the British, it is announced officially. The statement says 1,600 Turks were captured.

Following is the official statement: "On Tuesday our troops captured a strong enemy position consisting of six lines of entrenchments with six main redoubts and a central keep, covering Rafa, 30 miles northeast of El Arish. The attacking force, composed of Anzac mounted troops and the Imperial Camel Corps, left El Arish on Monday, and the attack on the position commenced at 7 o'clock on the morning of Tuesday. The fighting lasted until 2 in the afternoon when the position was finally carried."

CLAIM DESTRUCTION OF BRITISH WAR BALLOONS

German Say Their Airplanes Shot Them Down—Admit Beaumont Defeat.
Berlin, Jan. 11.—Via Sayville.—British troops made an attack yesterday on German positions north of Ypres, and the German army was forced to retreat in penetrating the German defenses at one point, but were expelled by a counter-attack.

CROWN PRINCE REMOVED FROM ARMY COMMAND

May Become Governor of Belgium Now, Says Paris Report.
London, Jan. 11.—A dispatch to the Associated Press from Paris says: "I have just confirmed from a neutral source usually very well informed that Crown Prince William now has been deprived of an effective military command. He may follow a course of treatment at Wiesbaden. I hear further it is thought possible that he may be appointed to take Gen. von Bissing's place at the head of the Government of occupation in Belgium."

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A MODERN CRUSADE

TRUTH OF BELGIUM WOULD BRING MORE THAN MERE WORDS

Paris, Jan. 11.—Cardinal Mercier, in a private letter printed in La Croix, the official church organ, declares that if the truth were known about Belgium, neutral nations would not confine themselves to words. The Belgian cardinal declares that Belgium is now suffering as never before. He writes: "We are all prisoners here, but if the neutrals know of the treatment inflicted on us, I do not believe that they would confine themselves to verbal remonstrances. If they did, we should have to do with a few scraps of charity and humanity."

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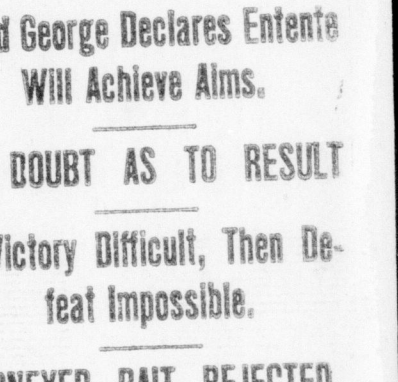
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
