In effecting this, do not imagine that England has abstained from carrying out gigantic enterprizes, sustaining mighty struggles, and defending her wide spread dominions with an armed hand. She possessed, in 1816, 80,000,000 of subjects; she now numbers 100,000,000. Canada revolted; the revolt was suppressed by force. Her will was contested in the Syriah question; her ships decided the matter. China resisted the odious commerce in opium; an expedition after the manner of Cortes subdued the Celestial Empire. Two seas existed, the entrance of which was not under the command of England, the Chinese Ocean and the Red Sea. Aden and Singapore have completed the chain of forts which bind the commerce of the world.
