



In the Labor world the outlook is on the whole more reassuring. A temporary peace has been effected in the Welsh coal trade and negotiations are tending toward peace in the shipbuilding industry, as also on the railways. In the cotton trade a great lockout is threatened, but I am assured that in certain important quarters the trouble is not taken too seriously. The cause of he unrest in the Labor world is the sectional disputes, and employers generally feel that there must be an end to these, and in that the leaders of the men themselves are at one with the employers. So that the hope is strongly held that some means will be found of checking this particular evil. Collective bargaining will I think, come well out of the present turmoil, but by what means this devoutly to he wished consummation will be attained, it is at present not easy to say.
