The Geological Survey reports the world's output of platinum for 1912 as \$14,781 Troy ounces, of which Russia contributed 200,000 ounces and Colombia 12,000 ounces. In the United States 721 ounces were produced, while the imports into this country aggregate \$4,008,082 in value in the same period. Platinum is now worth \$46 an ounce against \$20 five years ago.
