ANNUAL FAIR AT

NEW WESTMINSTER

Entries Exceed Those of Recent Years—Magnificent Display of Fruit.

New Westminster, Oct. 13.—The Provincial Fair was formally opened Tuesday at New Westminster by Hon. Mr. McBride in the presence of a number of R. A. & I. Society officers, civic officials and spectators.

The Premier said this show was one of Canada's best shows, ranking with the best of North America. The stock, dairy and agricultural exhibits about the farmsteads which experts said put them side by side with the finest products of America. The poultry exhibit, he was informed, was the best ever seen at New Westminster.

When this was remedied. He presented the best wishes of the Lieutenant-Governor, who would have unhesitatingly been had it not been for the awful calamity at Extension, and in closing paid high tributes to the work of President Trapp and Manager Keeley at the exhibition. With the exception of the present and past successes of the show, when the time came to write the history of the New Westminster exhibition these names, along with that of Mr. Brynner, would have an honored place.

At the annual exhibition, the entries this year in the product of the farm, stock, dairy and orchard have surpassed in number those of recent years, and the excellence of many features of the display of provincial productiveness is noteworthy. The fisheries exhibit, arranged by the Dominion government, is an attraction both interesting and instructive. The glory of the provincial fair is to be found in the magnificent display of fruit from Coast and inland orchards.

Chicago, Oct. 14.—The state food commission has started a crusade against dealers deceiving the public with artificially colored and smoked fish, hams, bacon, sausage and other meats. The investigators had their attention attracted through the cheap prices at which smoked salmon was offered. Examination showed that most of the "salmon" in the market was carp from the Fox river and other nearby streams. They were first given a wash of pink paint and then subjected to treatment in "liquid smoke." The ingredients of these are not classed as deadly poisons, but are recognized as having "accumulative effect" meaning that constant consumption will produce death.

The principal criminal case is that of Frank Kootenay, an Indian, charged with the wilful murder of another Indian named Antone Baptiste, near Grassy Point, on the Arrow lakes, on August 15th. One Lockheed, of Fernie, is charged with theft in connection with the Fernie fire relief fund of last year. About a dozen civil cases are on the list for trial, but none of them promise to be of more than local interest.

A. M. Johnson has been retained to defend Frank Kootenay and R. S. Lennie will represent the crown. The aluminum coins issued to Nigeria, East Africa, and Uganda during 1906 and 1907 have been found unsuitable for such tropical climates, and are being replaced by nickel bronze coins.
