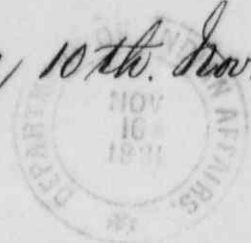

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th. July last No. 8255, relative to the advisability of instructing the Indian Agents to inspect the different Indian Reserves within their districts at other times than when they pay the Indians their annuities; and requesting me to consult with Mr. Inspector McColl on his return to Winnipeg as to the special Reserves which it might be considered advisable for each agent to visit in the fall of the year as recommended by Mr. Dewdney & myself.
