

As previously announced by the Prime Minister's Office, the Prime Minister of India, Mrs. Indira Gandhi, will visit Canada June 17-24, 1973. Precise details of the visit have still to be arranged and will be announced later but news agencies will be interested to know, for planning purposes, that it is anticipated that Mrs. Gandhi will visit the following cities during her stay in Canada: Ottawa - June 17-19
Toronto/Niagara - June 20
Montreal - June 21
Vancouver/Victoria - June 22-24

Bona fide news media representatives, i.e. reporters, photographers, cameramen, radio and television technicians, etc. who derive all, or a substantial portion, of their income from news gathering and news reporting activities who wish to cover Prime Minister Gandhi's visit must apply for proper accreditation to the Department of External Affairs, Ottawa. Applications for accreditation must be received by the Department on or before Friday, June 8, 1973 in order to be considered.

Applications for accreditation must include an appropriate letter from an official of the news agency concerned and must include the following information and be accompanied by two photographs (size 1½ x 1½) of the applicant:

- a. full name
- b. home address
- c. business address
- d. news media affiliation
- e. function (i.e. reporter, photographer, technician, etc.)
- f. date of birth
- g. place of birth

It is particularly important that applications be submitted early and, as indicated, above, they must be received not later than Friday, June 8, 1973. Applications and accompanying photographs should be sent to the following address: Press Office (FPR)
