## DEFENCE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TO VANCOUVER FIRMS

**Hon. C. M. Drury (Minister of Industry):** In so far as Defence Construction (1951) Limited is concerned, the answer is as follows:

May 30, 1958, Dawson & Hall Ltd., \$239,641, Construction of R.C.A.S.C. garage services area, Whitehorse, Y.T.

Sept. 15, 1959, Dawson & Hall Ltd., \$54,777, Construction of fixed Tacan station, Whitehorse, Y.T.

Nov. 17, 1961, Dawson & Hall Ltd., \$819,776, construction of a warehouse, p.o.l. bulk storage building, alterations to garage, erection and finishing fire hall (building owner supplied) and services, Camp Takhini, Whitehorse, Y.T.

April 27, 1961, Dawson, Wade & Co. Ltd., \$19,850, asphalt paving of Range road, Camp Takhini, Whitehorse, Y.T.

July 24, 1961, Dawson, Wade & Co. Ltd., \$14,742, asphalt paving of Ortona avenue and Normandy road, Camp Takhini, Whitehorse, Y.T.
